



## Emergency Manager's Weekly Report Coronavirus Pandemic Situation Report #60 (October 5<sup>th</sup>)

### Global Highlights:

- The World Health Organization (WHO) reports that as of October 5<sup>th</sup> there are 35,109,317 cases of Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) and 1,035,341 deaths:
  - Five countries (namely India, the United States of America, Brazil, Argentina, and France) reported 60% of new global cases this past week, while Israel registered the highest incidence (3,717 new cases per 1 million population).
  - In several countries, the number of new cases is rising again, and in many (most notably within the European Region) the second wave is exceeding previous peaks; this can be partly attributed to enhancements in surveillance capacities over time.
- Globally, the highest percentage of cases have been reported in the 25-39 age group, with approximately 50% of cases in the 25-64 age group. However, the percentage of deaths increases with age, and approximately 75% of deaths are in those aged 65 years and above.
- The COVAX initiative is supporting the development of nine COVID-19 vaccines. To support the development of these vaccines a total of 500 hospitals in 29 countries are participating.
- The WHO Director-General has stressed that this virus cannot be contained by one state alone and must be confronted by working together.
- As of October 2nd, the [Solidarity Response Fund](#) has raised or committed more than \$237 Million from more than 613,000 donors around the world.



### United States of America Highlights:

- The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) are reporting 7,396,740 cases and 209,199 deaths:
  - In the past seven days there has been 36,778 new cases and 378 new deaths.
  - As of September 27, COVID-19 cases were trending upward in 26 states, especially in the West and central parts of the country. In the last week, six states reported more than 10,000 new cases.
- On October 5<sup>th</sup>, the CDC issued updated guidance to its “How COVID-19 Spreads” [website](#), which includes information about the potential for airborne spread of the virus.
- As of October 2<sup>nd</sup>, a cumulative total of 115,475,943 people was tested for COVID-19 nationwide.
- A total of 16,763 National Guard troops and 1,293 Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) employees were deployed nationwide.
- FEMA Operation Center Status:
  - National Response Coordination Center: Conducting COVID response operations
  - Regional Response Coordination Centers (RRCC):
    - ✓ Regions I, II, III, V, VI, & X at Level III
    - ✓ Regions IV, VII, VIII, & IX are rostered
    - ✓ Regions VII, VIII, & IX working from the Virtual JFO
